## ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII, Chapter 7-1-1 "ELECTRIC UTILITY".

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTEMORE, IOWA:

SECTION 1. The City Code of Whittemore, Iowa, 2007, is amended by repealing all previous ordinances pertaining to "Electric Utility Rates", and is adopted in lieu thereof:

- 7-1-1 SERVICE RULES AND REGULATION. The rules and regulations for service are contained in the Municipal Electric Utility of the City of Whittemore Tariff, on file with the Iowa State Commerce Commission. Also, an official copy of the rules and regulations as adopted is now on file in the office of the clerk. The rules and regulations contained therein shall apply to all users of the municipal electric system.
- 7-1-1 RATES. The rates for electric service shall be as follows, with the city reserving the right to adjust rates to reflect supplier increases.
  - 1. Residential Rate. This residential rate shall be applicable to the total amount of kilowatts used by each residential customer each month.
    - \$0.10098 per kWh plus appropriate taxes
  - 2. Commercial Rate. This commercial rate shall be applicable to the total amount of kilowatts used each month by each nonresidential customer at one location.

\$0.07941 per kWh plus appropriate taxes

- 3. Whittemore Housing Units. The Whittemore Housing Units have 1 electric meter for six apartments and/or 5 electric meters for four apartments and shall be charged as follows:
  - \$0.10098 per kWh plus appropriate taxes
- 4. Farm Service Charge: \$15.00 per month.
- 5. Every potential customer shall pay \$15.00 connect fee, if service was disconnected by previous customer.
- 6. Monthly Billing. The monthly bills for all utility services shall be mailed on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the following month. Bills shall be due and payable by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. Those bills not paid by that date shall be increased by ten (10%) percent. That bill must be paid in full before any payment may be accredited to any consequent bills.

Residential - \$10.00 plus applicable taxes, per meter, per month Commercial - \$10.00 plus applicable taxes, per meter, per month Industrial (A I Processors & MaxYield Coop) - \$10.00 plus applicable taxes, per meter, per month SECTION 2. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional; such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole, or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect starting with the June, 2012 bills which are due on or before July 20, 2012.
