To enter the contest, complete and sign this entry form.

1. Entry fee is \$50 with a total \$1,000.00 divided between Top 3 purse and trophies.
2. Each team must provide own: **Pork Ribs**, cooking device and all equipment necessary for cooking.
3. Meat may not be pre-cooked, sauced, spiced, injected, marinated or cured in advance: it must all be done on sight after your ribs have been inspected.
4. Check in time is 7:00-8:30am -or- 9:30-12noon due to St. Michael's 5K Run. **No moving of vehicles during the 5K (8:30-9:30) All cook-off contestants must be registered by 12:00noon.**
5. Absolutely no garnish will be allowed. Any garnish will lead to disqualification.
6. **Rib turn in time is 4:00pm**
7. **"People's Choice" rib judging 4:30 - 6:00pm ALL AWARDS @ 6:30pm**

8. Sauce is optional. If used, it shall be applied directly to the meat while cooking and not pooled or puddled in the container. Sauce violation shall receive a score of "1" on appearance.
9. Entries will be submitted in a numbered container that will be supplied. Each contestant must submit at least 6 separate ribs. Meat shall not be sculptured, branded or in rosettes. Aluminum foil, toothpicks, skewers or other garnish is not allowed in entry.
10. The following Cleanliness and Safety Rules will be applied:
 - A. No use of any tobacco products while handling meat.
 - B. Cleanliness of the cook, assistants, cooking device and cooking space is required.
 - C. Shirt/Shoes are required to be worn in cooking area.
 - D. Sanitizing of work area should be implemented.
 - E. Prior to cooking: meat must be maintained at 40 degrees or above
 - F. After cooking meat: Meat must be held at 140 degrees or above
11. Coolers are allowed and electricity is available.
